**Subject: Sanction of payment of Rs. 200 Lakh (Two Crore only) from GIA-G (RAMP) to Central Tool Room (CTR) Ludhiana for onward payment to IPFCs towards facilitation of 100 GI products by various IPFCs as per Table A under IPR Component of MSME Innovative scheme-reg.**

Sanction of the President of India is hereby conveyed to release of payment of amount of Rs. 200 Lakh (Two Crore only) to CNA i.e. Central Tool Room (CTR) Ludhiana under Grant-in-aid General (RAMP) for onward release to various IP Facilitation centre (IPFCs) as per Table A below towards filing new 100 GI products under IPR Component of MSME Innovative scheme approved in 8<sup>th</sup> meeting of PMAC held on date 29.11.2024 for the F.Y. 2025-26. The details of the One District One GI (ODOG) programmes allocated to IPFCs are as under in **Table A**:

**2. General Guidelines:**

The Grant-in-Aid will be regulated in accordance with the OM of Dept. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide No. 1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 regarding revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes on BHOs contained in the

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 Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises  
 विकास आयुक्त (सू. ल. एवं म. उद्यम) का कार्यालय  
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IPR Component of MSME Innovative Scheme. CTR, Ludhiana shall strictly follow the roles and responsibility as mentioned in the aforesaid O.M. The funds released are also subject to the provisions contained in Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard and in particular to the following conditions:

- i) CTR, Ludhiana shall maintain CNA account of Grant-in-Aid received from the Government and utilized. In addition, a separate Bank account shall be maintained for the Government Grants under this scheme. (The bank account should be same which was authorized for operation at the time of registration under the central plan Scheme monitoring system (CPSMS) of the Ministry of Finance).
- ii) The grant shall be utilized for the purpose of facilitating "One District One GI" under IPR component of MSME Innovative Scheme as provisioned in the scheme guideline. Further, while incurring the expenditure, austerity measures should be taken into account as issued from time to time by competent authority.
- iii) CTR, Ludhiana shall maintain a register of permanent and semi-Permanent assets acquired if any, wholly or mainly out of the above grant in the prescribed format and copy thereof should be furnished to this Ministry.
- iv) If any capital assets created in the CTR, Ludhiana, DC (MSME) will be the sole proprietor of the same. Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grant shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grant-in-aid.
- v) The accounts of CTR, Ludhiana shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Controller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC) Act, 1971 in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section 14 of the C&AG (DPC) Act, 1971, as amended from time to time and Internal Audit party of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), whenever it is called upon to do so.
- vi) The grantee shall submit the Utilization Certificate in the prescribed form GFR-12 duly signed by the Head of the Institution/Grantee latest by 31.03.2026. The utilization certificate in respect of grants should also disclose whether the stipulated, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been reached against the amount utilized were in fact reached, and if not, the reasons thereof furnished by concerned IA/IPFC.
- vii) CTR, Ludhiana shall furnish an Audited Statement of Accounts of the financial year before 30.04.2026 also indicating separately Activity-wise and Head-wise expenditure.
- viii) Grant-in-Aid shall be utilized subject to the Economy and other Instructions issued from time to time by the MoF in Finance or by the Competent Authority.
- ix) CTR, Ludhiana shall certify that the utilization certificates due for submission for the Grants-in-aid sanctioned in the previous year's containing all the relevant details under GFR 212(1) have been submitted to the satisfaction of the Ministry of MSME.
- x) CTR, Ludhiana shall adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR and any other instructions/guidelines issued by the Government from time to time, while making procurement/purchases of goods and services including compliance to GFR provisions in case of out-sourcing of services and engagement of consultants.

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- xi) CTR, Ludhiana has been exempted from execution of the bond. CTR, Ludhiana shall, however, furnish an undertaking that it will comply with all the terms and conditions stipulated in the sanction order.
- xii) CTR, Ludhiana should send pre-receipted bill and undertaking to agree to the terms & conditions of this sanction (in triplicate) to this Ministry for payment of the amount drawn against this sanction.
- xiii) In no case the grant released under this sanction will be utilized for any purpose other than those indicated in the sanction. The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the Scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organization and shall abide by the terms & conditions of the grant and follow/adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR regarding Grants in aid. If the grantee does not adhere to the terms & conditions of Grant and GFR provisions, the grantee/Institution shall be required to refund the grant with interest @10% per annum, if any.
- xiv) CTR, Ludhiana will send the detailed progress report of fund utilized by IAs/IPFCs.
- xv) CTR, Ludhiana may use the fund as prescribed in the Scheme guidelines of IPR component of MSME Innovative Scheme guidelines. The expenditure under the sanction is maximum, saving if any, will be surrendered to the Govt. of India.
- xvi) The grantee institution shall not utilize the interest earned if any on the recurring/non-recurring grants-in-aid released to the institution for any purpose. The interest earned shall be indicated in UC which can be either adjusted in next release or to be refunded to Gol after grants-in-aid sanctioned is utilized.
- xvii) The financial assistance will be utilized for filing of GIs only and will be as per actual, subject to maximum cap of Rs. 2 Lakh per GI.

3. Apart from the terms and conditions given in the detailed guidelines of the MSME Innovative Scheme, the other terms and conditions of the approval for release of funds to the above-mentioned IPFCs are specifically subjected to the following:

- i. The IPFC shall serve as a facilitator for producers and stakeholders in the district, guiding them through the application process for registering GI products. This involves providing assistance in preparing and submitting the necessary documentation.
- ii. IPFC shall be responsible for scrutinizing the applications to ensure that they meet the criteria for GI registration. This includes verifying the geographical origin of the product and assessing its unique qualities or characteristics linked to that specific region.
- iii. The IPFC shall act as a liaison between local authorities and the GI registry, streamlining communication and ensuring a smooth exchange of information. This coordination will expedite the registration process and addressing any queries or concerns raised during the process.
- iv. IPFC shall engage in promoting awareness about the significance of GIs among local producers, consumers, and relevant stakeholders.
- v. IPFC Shall furnish a detailed report about the GI interventions with measurable outcomes.
- vi. IPFCs would ensure that they have not availed grant-in-aid for the same purpose or activities from any other Ministry/Department of Govt. of India.

- vii. The expenditure incurred by the IPFC shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority/CAG/ Internal Audit Party of the Chief Controller of Accounts, Ministry of MSME.
- viii. In the event of violation of any of the terms and conditions of this order, the organization will have to refund the entire sanctioned amount to the O/o DC MSME on demand or such part thereof along with penal interest as per the government rates.

5. The progress of the scheme would be monitored by the PMAC, O/o DC MSME.
