76th meeting of the Techno Economic Appraisal Committee (TEAC) of Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP) was held on 15.06.2021 at New Delhi through Video Conferencing under the Chairmanship of AS&DC (MSME) to consider technical suitability & viability of various project proposals of Common Facility Centre (CFC) and Infrastructure Development (ID) and to recommend the same for approval of National Level Steering Committee (NLSC).

AS&DC (MSME) welcomed the participants and expressed the need for the focused efforts for promoting MSE-CDP in States on large scale and also for paying attention to regular monitoring of the already approved projects.



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

- iii. State may focus on the ongoing schemes and take measures to complete them at the earliest.
