- 2. The Director/Incharge, MSME-DIs should adhere to:
- Funds are under the Plan Scheme and non- recurring in nature.
- ii) MSME-DIs will keep separate accounts utilization for the sanctioned fund. The saving, if any, is not transferrable.
- iii) The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of these funds should not, without the prior sanction of Government of India, be disposed or encumbered or utilized for the purpose other than that for which the funds have been sanctioned.
- iv) The Progress report on utilization of the sanctioned fund should be sent periodically/ within a month after the completion of the concerned trade fairs/ exhibition/seminars/awareness programs.
