

Minutes of the 8th Meeting of Project Approval and Monitoring Committee (PAMC) under the scheme component "Promotion of MSMEs in NE Region and Sikkim".

In the Chair: Secretary, MSME

At the outset, Secretary (MSME) welcomed the participants and asked brief about the Agenda of the meeting and the same was briefed by Director (NER).

The minutes of the 7th meeting of PAMC were confirmed.

Director (NER) submitted that there are sixteen proposals for consideration, out of which twelve proposals were considered in the 7th Meeting of the PAMC held on 10th January, and given in-principle approval with observations.

Director (NER) explained the proposals for consideration of PAMC as under;

1. "Establishment of Industrial Estate in the form of flatted factory complex" at Deorali, Gangtok, Sikkim- proposal submitted by Commerce & Industry Department, Sikkim under sub component- "Development of new & existing industrial estate".

The proposal was given in-principle approval in the 7th PAMC. As per the observation of PAMC, the committee comprising of an officer from NER Division of DC-MSME, civil expert engaged with TCSP division of DC-MSME and an officer from concerned MSME-DI visited the site and found the proposal in order.

The proposal has been approved with the total project cost Rs.5.15 Cr., Gol grant Rs.4.12 Cr., and the State share Rs.1.03 Cr. The flatted factory complex (FFC) will provide, working space to the local entrepreneurs in the field of IT, Incubation Centre and Co-working space to entrepreneurs. The Flatted Factory Complex will also provide housing to the agencies engaged in promotion of MSMEs namely MSME-DI Gangtok, NSIC and MSME Division of the State Commerce and Industries Department under the roof of the complex.

2. "Development of facilities for Sheep & Angora Wool processing unit" Namthang, Sikkim- Proposal by Krishi Vigyan Kendra (an autonomous body of Govt. of Sikkim) under sub component- "Other Activities".

The proposal approved as per the agenda with the total project cost Rs.8.27 Cr., Gol grant Rs.7.44 Cr. and the State share Rs.0.83 Cr. The committee opined that dedicated efforts should be made by the State Govt. for marketing of the sheep & angora wool products including brand promotion. The quality of the products needs to be assured so that products are export worthy.

3. Development of industrial estate at Industrial Growth Centre, Luangmual- by Commerce & Industry Department, Govt. of Mizoram under sub component- "Development of new & existing industrial estate" .

The proposal was given in-principle approval in the 7th PAMC. As per the observation of PAMC, the committee comprising of an officer from NER Division of DC-MSME, civil expert engaged with TCSP division of DC-MSME and an officer from concerned MSME-DI visited the site and found the proposal in order.

The proposal has been approved as per the agenda with the total project cost Rs.9.84 Cr., Gol grant Rs.7.85 Cr. and State share Rs.1.99 Cr.

4. Development of industrial estate at Export Promotion Industrial Park (EPIP), Lengte - by Commerce & Industry Department, Govt. of Mizoram under sub component- "Development of new & existing industrial estate"

The proposal was given in-principle approval in the 7th PAMC. As per the observation of PAMC, the committee comprising of an officer from NER Division of DC-MSME, civil expert engaged with TCSP division of DC-MSME and an officer from concerned MSME-DI visited the site and found the proposal in order.

The proposal has been approved as per the agenda with the total project cost of Rs.9.72 Cr., out of which Gol grant is Rs.7.77 Cr. and State share Rs.1.95 Cr.

5. Extension Centre of NTTC, Dimapur at Kiphire- by Govt. of Nagaland Under sub component- "Setting up new and modernization of existing Mini Technology Centres".

The proposal has been approved subject to assurance from State Govt. of Nagaland about the long term self sustainability of the project. The approved total project cost is Rs.11.75 Cr., out of which Rs. 8.00 Cr. as Gol grant and Rs.03.75 Cr. as State share.

6. Setting up of a New Micro Industrial Estate, Jagiroad, Distt. Morigaon, Assam - by Industries & Commerce Department, Govt. of Assam, (AIIDC) under sub component- "Development of new & existing industrial estate".

The proposal was given in-principle approval in the 7th PAMC. As per the observation of PAMC, the committee comprising of an officer from NER Division of DC-MSME, civil expert engaged with TCSP division of DC-MSME and an officer from concerned MSME-DI visited the site and found the proposal in order.

The proposal has been approved as per the agenda with the total project cost of Rs.9.93 Cr., out of which Gol grant is Rs.7.94 Cr., the State share Rs.1.99 Cr.

7. Up-gradation of existing industrial Area at Rani, Distt. Kamrup, Assam by Industries & Commerce Department, Govt. of Assam, (AIIDC) under sub component- "Development of new & existing industrial estate".

The proposal was given in-principle approval in the 7th PAMC. As per the observation of PAMC, the committee comprising of an officer from NER Division of DC-MSME, civil expert engaged with TCSP division of DC-MSME and an officer from concerned MSME-DI visited the site and found the proposal in order.

The proposal has been approved as per the agenda with the total project cost of Rs.5.56 Cr., out of which Gol grant is Rs. 4.44 Cr., the State share Rs.1.12 Cr.

8. Up-gradation of Integrated infrastructure Development Centre at Bhomoraguri and Naltoli, Distt.- Nagaon, Assam - by Industries & Commerce Department, Govt. of Assam, (AIDC) under sub component- "Development of new & existing industrial estate".

The proposal was given in-principle approval in the 7th PAMC. As per the observation of PAMC, the committee comprising of an officer from NER Division of DC-MSME, civil expert engaged with TCSP division of DC-MSME and an officer from concerned MSME-DI visited the site and found the proposal in order.

The proposal has been approved as per the agenda with the total project cost of Rs.12.96 Cr., Gol grant Rs.8.00 Cr., State share Rs. 4.96 Cr. The total project cost is for two different locations, the bifurcated cost of all components at each plot site has to be submitted by Implementing Agency before release of Gol grant.

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9. Setting up of New Industrial Estate at Dhanubhanga, Rongjuli, Distt.-Goalpara, Assam - by Industries & Commerce Department, Govt. of Assam, (AIDC) under sub component- "Development of new & existing industrial estate".

The proposal was given in-principle approval in the 7th PAMC. As per the observation of PAMC, the committee comprising of an officer from NER Division of DC-MSME, civil expert engaged with TCSP division of DC-MSME and an officer from concerned MSME-DI visited the site and found the proposal in order.

The proposal has been approved as per the agenda with the total project cost Rs.14.30 Cr., out of which Gol grant Rs. 8.00 Cr., State share Rs. 6.30 Cr.

10. "Proposal for Development of IT Modules for Ease of Doing Business for MSEs" at AEDC, Guwahati- by Assam Electronics Development Corporation Ltd, Assam, under sub component- "Other Activities"

The proposal has been approved as per the agenda with the following observations;

- a) There will be a dedicated window for grievance redressal in time bound manner.
- b) The Govt. of Assam may provide free of cost software to the NER states and Sikkim including training on how to use the software.

The approved total project cost is Rs.91.69 Lakh, out of which, Gol grant will be Rs.82.52 Lakh, the State share Rs.9.17 Lakh.

11. Research Study on "Strategy for export promotion from North Eastern India to ASEAN in the back drop of 'Act East Policy'" - by Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, Kolkata (an Autonomous body of Govt. of India) under sub component- "Other Activities".

The proposal was presented by Dr. Tamanna Chaturvedi, Asstt. Prof. IIFT.

The proposal has been approved with the observation that report will include directory of all products having export potential with details covering all the NER states & Sikkim. The approved total project cost is Rs.40.0 Lakh with Gol grant Rs.40.0 Lakh+ GST.

12. Research Study on "Start-ups of NER and Sikkim" by National Productivity Council, New Delhi(an Autonomous body of Govt. of India) under sub component - "Other activities"

The proposal was presented by Ms. Kritika Shukla, Dy. Director, NPC. The Research Study proposal approved with the following observations:

- a) For preparation of report detailed consultation with DPIIT and Start-up policy guidelines, outcome of the policy should be made.
- b) Best practices relating to Start-ups of other States suitable for NER & Sikkim should be included
- c) Start-up policy of Israel, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand etc. where Start-up has high success rate should be studied and given place in the report.

The approved total project cost is Rs.79.30 Lakh with Gol grant Rs.79.30 Lakh+ GST.

13. Setting up of "Mini Dairy Processing Technology Centre at Temi Tea Estate, South Sikkim - by Temi Tea Estate, Govt. of Sikkim

The proposal has been approved as per the agenda with the total project cost Rs.1.00 Cr., out of which Gol grant is Rs.0.90 Cr. and the State share Rs.0.10 Cr. The committee emphasized that highest attention should be given for quality of the products being the food item.

14. Setting up of "Technology Centre for promotion of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants through infrastructure development in Nagaland" at Razhaphe Basa, Distt. Dimapur- by Nagaland Bio Resource Mission, Govt. of Nagaland.

The Project has been approved in-principle with the following observations:

- a) The project will be considered for final approval after vetting of DPR jointly by CIMAP, Lucknow and FFDC, Kannauj.
- b) The State Govt. of Nagaland has to give assurance that the CIMAP will be the mentor for the project for a minimum period of three years since inception.
- c) For hiring of manpower, the CIMAP will essentially be involved.
- d) Cost reduction for civil work should be explored through an expert (Civil-retired from CPWD) engaged in TCSP Division and one officer from NER Section.

15. Up-gradation of "Khliehtyrshi Industrial Estate", Distt. West Jaintia Hills- by Meghalaya Industrial Development Corporation Ltd, Shillong.

The project has been deferred as it appears that it is not an eco-friendly project. A team of experts comprising the officer from DC(MSME) and expert agency such as Indian Plywood Industries Research & Training Institute, Bangalore may visit the site and find the ways for utilization of Wood Waste in place of its incineration.

16. Up-gradation of "Mawiaban Industrial Estate, Nongstoin", West Khasi Hills- by Meghalaya Industrial Development Corporation Ltd, Shillong.

The project has been deferred as it appears that it is not an eco-friendly project. A team of experts comprising the officer from DC(MSME) and expert agency such as Indian Plywood Industries Research & Training Institute, Bangalore may visit the site and find the ways for utilization of Wood Waste in place of its incineration.
