Sanction of the President of India is hereby conveyed to release of payment of a token amount of Rs. 1.00 (Rupees One Only) to be credited to CNA-CTTC-Bhubaneswar under Grant-in-aid General under IPR component of MSME Innovative scheme to various Implementing Agencies (IAs)/IP Facilitation Centre ( IPFCs) for conducting 321 nos. of IP Awareness Programme for an amount of Rs. 224.70 lakh approved in 5th meeting of PMAC held on dt. 14.7.2023 for the FY 2023-24. 2. This is in accordance with the Department of Expenditure's OM no.3(17)/PFMS/2022 dated 5th September, 2023 (copy enclosed) which has provided following relaxations/advice:

- i. Relaxation from validation check put in PFMS granted to MoMSME till 31st December, 2023 to generate sanction orders in PFMS for token amount not exceeding Rs. 1 (one) in each case. Once the sanction order is issued, CNA can assign adequate financial limit to the project in PFMS to enable utilization from the amount balance in the CNA account concerned.
- ii. For redistribution of limits assigned to various sub agencies, MoMSME may follow the procedure prescribed in DoE's OM No. 3(04)/PFMS/2022 dated 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 (copy enclosed).

2.1 This Sanction Order gives effect to the MoF's advice as per Para-2 (i) above.

3. Accordingly, the "Sanctioned Amount" and the "Release Amount" are as under:

4. Roles and Responsibilities of CNA:

**Special Guidelines in accordance with DoE's OM no. 3(17)/PFMS/2022 dated 5th September, 2023 (ref. para-2.1 above):**

4.1 There will be no correlation with the bank balance lying in the CNA bank account and the assignment of financial limits by the PD, MSME to the CNA and/or by the CNA to the SAs (IAs).

4.2 The Programme Division (PD), MSME will enhance the drawing limit of the CNA by the 'Sanctioned' amount mentioned in this Sanction Order.

4.3 Central Tool Room and Training Centre (CTTC), Bhubaneswar, Odisha (CNA) shall assign the financial limits to the respective IPFCs/IAs as per the 'Sanctioned' amount mentioned against each of the IPFC/IA above as per the scheme guidelines.

4.4 The CNA shall promptly intimate the Ministry once the actual bank balance in the CNA Bank Account reaches the level of **Rs. 1.70 crore** [approx. 6.25% of the budget of Rs.27.00 crore earmarked for the CNA (CTTC, Bhubaneswar) in the FY 2023-24)], so that fresh fund release out of the 'Sanctioned' amount of this Sanction Order can be processed and released.

**General Guidelines:**

4.5 The Grant-in-Aid will be regulated in accordance with the OM of Dept. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide No. 1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 (copy attached) regarding revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector

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
