SANCTION ORDER

Subject: Sanction of payment of Rs. 9,89,000/- under NER to Quality Council of India (QCI), New Delhi towards promotion and implementation of MSME Sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme for FY 2023-24: reg.

Sanction of the President of India is hereby conveyed to release of payment of **Rs. 9,89,000/-** (Rupees Nine Lakh Eighty Nine Thousand Only) under Grant-in-aid General (NER) for implementation of MSME Sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme, a component of MSME Champions, to Quality Council of India (QCI), New Delhi w.r.t. their proposal dated 01.12.2023. The details are as under:

The Grant-in-Aid will be regulated in accordance with the OM of Dept. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide No. 1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated 9th March, 2022 (copy attached) regarding revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes and provisions contained in the MSME Sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme guidelines. QCI has been nominated as CNA vide letter No. 41(1)/Budget/MSME Champions/2021 dated 27.06.2022 for MSME Sustainable (ZED) and MSME Competitive (Lean) component of MSME Champions Scheme (copy of the CNA order enclosed). QCI shall strictly follow the roles and responsibility as mentioned in the aforesaid O.M. The funds released are also subject to the provisions contained in Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard and in particular to the following conditions:

Cast

- (i) The Quality Council of India shall maintain separate account of Grant-in-Aid received from the Government and utilized. In addition, a separate Bank account shall be maintained for the Government Grants. *(The bank account should be same which was authorized for operation at the time of registration under the 'Central Plan Scheme Monitoring System' (CPSMS) of the Ministry of Finance).*
- (ii) The grant shall be utilized for the purpose of conducting Minimum 50 no. of participants and 20 no of new pledges per awareness programme under ZED as provisioned in the guideline must be ensured and efforts should be made to select participants from SC, ST, OBC, PH, women & minority categories of MSMEs. Further, while incurring the expenditure austerity measures should be taken into account as issued from time to time by competent authority.
- (iii) www.udyamregistrarion.gov.in, www.champions.gov.in and www.zed.msme.gov.in portal to be used for all relevant information required while conducting the activities under MSME Sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme.
- (iv) All Covid-19 pandemic protocol, other related issues would be followed (in case of such situations and physical programme would be avoided), as issued by State /UT Govts. from time to time.
- (v) The allocated fund for NER would be utilized during FY 2023-24 or till first quarter of FY 2024-25.
- (vi) There would be follow up action of MSMEs for implementation of the Scheme.
- (vii) Quality Council of India, New Delhi may furnish their performance-cum-achievement report regularly.
- (viii) QCI should maintain a register of permanent and semi-permanent assets acquired wholly or mainly out of the above grant in the prescribed format and copy thereof should be furnished to this Ministry.
- (ix) If any capital assets created in the QCI, DC (MSME) will be the sole proprietor of the same. Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grant shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grant-in-aid.
- (x) The accounts of QCI shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Controller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC) Act, 1971 in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section 14 of the C&AG (DPC 1971) as amended from time to time and Internal Audit party of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), whenever it is called upon to do so.
- (xi) The grantee shall submit the Utilization Certificate in the prescribed form GFR-12 duly signed by the Head of the Institution/ Grantee latest by 31.03.2024. The utilization certificate in respect of grants should also disclose whether the specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been reached against the amount utilized were in fact reached, and if not, the reasons there for. They should contain an output-based performance assessment instead of input-based performance assessment.
- (xii) Quality Council of India (QCI), New Delhi shall furnish an Audited Statement of Accounts of the financial year before 30.04.2024 also indicating separately Activity-wise and Head-wise expenditure.
- (xiii) Grant-in-Aid shall be utilized subject to the Economy and other Instructions issued from time to time by the M/o Finance or by the Competent Authority.
- (xiv) Quality Council of India, New Delhi shall certify that the utilization certificates due for submission for the Grants-in-aid sanctioned in the previous years containing all the relevant details under GFR 212(1) have been submitted to the satisfaction of the Minister (Ministry of MSME).
- (xv) QCI shall certify that no grants for this purpose or activities have been applied for or obtained from any other Ministry or Department of the Government of India or State Government.


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
