

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

CGHS vide its O.M. nos. Z15025/19/2024/DIR/CGHS/EHS (Comp No. 8281286) dated 28.06.2024, Z15025/117/2024/CGHS/EHSS dated 15.01.2018 & 10.12.2018 has revised the guidelines for referral process in CGHS for simplification of procedures for the CGHS beneficiaries. It has been observed that some employees are frequently seeking ex-post facto approvals in general medical cases and are not complying with the CGHS guidelines.

2. The process of obtaining ex-post facto approvals may be seen as a mechanism to be used rarely in genuine difficult/exigency situations and this practice of routine checkups/diagnostic test without proper referrals should not be used on regular basis.
3. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
