

Terms and Conditions for appointment of National Program Manager for Technology Centre Systems Program – A World Bank funded project

1. The Government of India is to appoint a National Program Manager (NPM), who will be a full time functionary for the Technology Centre Systems Program, and is likely to continue till March 31 2020. The assignment is based at New Delhi, India and may involve extensive travel. The position will be at the level equivalent to the Director / Joint Secretary in Government of India. The roles and responsibilities are given in the ToR.
2. The opportunity is open for candidates from private or public sector officials who fulfil the requirements as mentioned below:
 - a. Post Graduate degree/diploma in Science / Engineering / Economic disciplines.
 - b. At least 15 years' experience of working with State or Central Government or PSU at a level equivalent to Group 'A' level in Government of India with demonstrable exposure in socio-economic developmental issues.
 - c. Demonstrable project formulation, implementation and / or management experience for a World Bank / ADB / Multilateral funded Projects in India is a must.
3. The applicants working in Central / State Government / Departments / PSUs need to apply following their service conditions and should submit their application through proper channel. However, they may submit an advance copy of the application which shall be considered, pending receipt of application through proper channel.
4. If a Government Official is selected, she / he would be offered assignment as per respective service rules and conduct guidelines; on deputation terms (foreign assignment) as this is a World Bank funded project.
5. The emoluments and other benefits & allowances would be as per rules, but negotiable.
6. The selected candidate would be required to join within 30 days from the date of issue of appointment letter.
